### **Dr. Mahmood Ghazi**

Dr. Mahmood Ghazi is a Professor of Sharia at the Faculty of Islamic Studies at Qatar Foundation and is the former Minister of Education and Religious Affairs in Pakistan as well as the former President of the International Islamic University in Islamabad. He comes from a distinguished line of scholars and received his early education at a traditional Madrasah before going on to complete his doctorate at the University of Punjab. He is the author of many books and an advisor to a number of institutions. Dr. Ghazi specializes in the History of Islamic Fiqh, its application and the challenges it faces today. He also has keen interest in traditional Islamic Education, especially the Darse-Nizami system widely used in the Indian Sub-continent.

### **Dr. Rasha Al-Disuqi**

Dr. Rasha Al-Disuqi is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Islamic Studies at Qatar Foundation. She is a distinguished author and lecturer who have lectured at some of the most prestigious academic institutions in the world including Al-Azhar University in Cairo as well as several other universities in the United States. She holds a Doctorate in Islamic Studies from the University of Wales. Dr. Al-Disuqi has published in leading scholarly publications and is the author of the best-selling book "The Resurgent Voice of Muslim Women, Muslim Family Fiqh and Unveiling Jihad (Or The Difference Between Resistance & Terrorism)". She has managed to clarify misconceptions and contributed to building bridges of communication between non-Muslims and Muslims.
